## Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Matrix – Structural Pest Control

### IPM Strategy Overview

Step	Description
Step 1: Inspection & Monitoring	Identify pest activity, entry points, and breeding sites.
Step 2: Physical & Mechanical Controls	Use non-chemical methods to reduce pest populations.
Step 3: Chemical Controls	Apply least-toxic EPA-registered products first; escalate only if necessary.

### Tier Ratings for Chemical Controls

- Green Tier – Least toxic
- Yellow Tier – Moderate toxicity
- Red Tier – Higher concern (use only when essential)

### Notes








- All chemical products listed are EPA-registered.
- Least-toxic options are prioritized in alignment with UCM's sustainability goals.
- Rodenticides and Red Tier products are used only when necessary and require approval.
